

# On Angels' Wings Fundraising Writing Competition

Write a short prose or essay of no more than 1,000 words or a poem inspired by images and stories of the children of Malayaka House, an orphanage in Uganda. The story has to relate to this topic in some way no matter how subtle (orphans, Africa, poverty, making a difference, love, loneliness, children, cultures, etc.)

Only one piece per student.

Entries will be judged based on creativity as well as style and voice. Winners will be chosen by a small reading committee.

Winning pieces will be published in a book – a collection of stories, essays, poems, and art- titled “On Angels’ Wings”. All proceeds from the book sales will go directly to Malayaka House. By submitting your work, you give permission to the fundraising committee to print your story and sell it worldwide.

All entries must be typed, and your name and student ID should appear on the top.

Deadline: you must submit your piece no later than December 1, 2014.

Submit your entry to Ms. Schiebel in room 209 or to the librarians before December 1, 2014.

In addition to the book, there will be a book preview event with music, food, and an art display on Nov. 3 at 6:30-8:00 pm in the Klein Oak Library.
